2024 Glen Eira Leisure's Olympic Decathlon Challenge – Terms and Conditions

By entering the challenge, you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions:

1. The competition is being run by Glen Eira City Council (Council) through Glen Eira Leisure (GEL), 200 East Boundary Rd Bentleigh East, 3165.

Eligibility

2. To be eligible to enter the challenge, an entrant must:

a. be an active member of GEL throughout the term of the challenge (Challenge Term), 26 July 2024 to 12 August 2024;

b. complete a number of the individual events on the GEL's Olympic Challenge card;

c. agree to provide evidence of eligibility to enter the challenge if selected as a Prize Winner.

3. Entrants under 18 years of age must have their parent or legal guardian's consent to enter the challenge.

4. If an entrant is under 18 years of age on the date a Prize is awarded, it will be awarded to their parent/legal guardian. By approving the entrant's participation or accepting any Prize on the entrant's behalf, the entrant's parent/legal guardian agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.

5. Council employees, contractors, Councillors, and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition.

6. All Prize Winners must meet the eligibility criteria stated in Clause 2.

7. Council reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process.

Entry

8. The competition opens on Friday 26 July 2024 at 5:45 am;

9. Eligible persons register for participation in the challenge by completing and submitting the registration form available on Glen Eira Leisure's website [GEL's Olympic Decathlon | Glen Eira Leisure (geleisure.com.au).

10. Limits of one entry per person.

11. Registration will close at 5 pm on 12 August 2024.

Prize draws

15. GEL's decision is final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Notification

16. Participants are required to approach reception with their GEL's Olympic Decathlon card to receive their prize on or before Friday 16th August.

17. GEL reserves the right, at any time, before awarding a Prize to verify the validity of entries by requesting:

17.1. proof that during the challenge period, the Prize Winner was an active member of GEL's Olympic Decathlon Challenge;

17.2. proof of age of the Prize Winner; and

17.3. proof of identification of the Prize Winner.

If the Prize Winner is unable to prove their eligibility by Friday 16 August, under clause 16, they will automatically forfeit their Prize.

Prize selection

19. Prizes are not exchangeable or redeemable for cash or other goods or services.

20. A Prize cannot be transferred to any other person unless approved by GEL.

21. A maximum of one Prize will be awarded to an entrant at the end of the Challenge period.

If, for any reason, any aspect of the challenge is not capable of running as planned, including because of tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of Council, Council may, in its absolute discretion, cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the challenge or invalidate any affected entries without any further recourse to the entrants.

28. If any act, omission, event or circumstance occurs which is beyond the reasonable control of GEL or Council and which prevents Council from complying with these terms and conditions, Council will not be liable for any failure to perform or delay in performing its obligations.

29. Council reserves the right to alter or amend these terms and conditions at any time without further recourse to the entrants.
